

By-law 679-2008

The Corporation of the Village of Lumby

Being a By-law to amend the Village of Lumby Burning By-law 635-2005

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Community Charter, being Bill 41, Section 7, passed by the Province of British Columbia May 8, 2003, as amended, provides that a Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws for municipal purposes providing for services, laws and other matters for community benefit and for fostering the economic, social and environmental well-being of its community, and;

**AND WHEREAS** Council is desirous to amend authority for the issuance of a Burning Permit

**NOW THEREFORE**, Council of the Village of Lumby, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**TITLE**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the ***“Village of Lumby Burning Amending By-law 679-2008 to the Village of Lumby Burning By-law 635-2005,***
2. That Section 2.1 Definitions, subsection (k), (l) and (o) be deleted and; 2(a)iv, be amended by deleting “acceptable to the Fire Chief or Fire Inspector” and;
3. That Section 4.1 be amended by deleting “Fire Chief of the Lumby and District Fire Department” and replace with to the “Village of Lumby”, and;
4. That Section 4.3 be amended by deleting “Fire Chief” and inserting “Village of Lumby designate”, and;
5. That Section 4.4 be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with the following:
  - 4.4. A Burning Permit will only be considered for the following:
    - 4.4 i For lands greater than one(1) acre for the purpose of fire fuel management
    - 4.4.ii That wood waste and slash from land development clearing within the Village of Lumby shall only be burnt with an Air Curtain Burner System
6. That Section 4.7 be amended by deleting “Fire Chief” and inserting “Village of Lumby designate” and;

7. That Section 4.8 be amended by deleting “Fire Chief and inserting “Village of Lumby Designate, and;
8. Section 5, Offences and Penalties be amended as follows:
9. Subsection 5.1 be amended by deleting “Fire Chief” and inserting “Village of Lumby designate” and
10. Subsection 5.2 be deleted in its entirety and;
11. That schedule “B” to the Village of Lumby Burning By-law 635-2005 be amended by deleting “Lumby and District Fire Department” and inserting “Village of Lumby” where it appears within Schedule “B” and delete the word “Fire Chief” from the signature line of Part 2 –Permit.


